

# VEHICLE SAFETY PROCEDURES

## **VEHICLE OPERATION STANDARDS**

- NO ROLLING STOPS COME TO A FULL AND COMPLETE STOP EVERY TIME.
   ACTUALLY LOOK BOTH DIRECTIONS BEFORE PROCEEDING. PRIVATE PROPERTY OR LOW-TRAFFIC AREAS ARE NOT EXCEPTIONS.
- **FOLLOWING DISTANCE** MAINTAIN A MINIMUM OF 1.5–2.0 SECONDS OF SPACE BETWEEN YOUR VEHICLE AND THE ONE IN FRONT. ALLOW MORE DISTANCE WHEN TRAVELING AT SPEEDS ABOVE 45 MPH.
- PANIC STOPPING EXCESSIVE OR HARSH BRAKING SHOULD NEVER BE NECESSARY WHEN DRIVING SAFELY.
- HARSH TURNS ADJUST SPEED APPROPRIATELY FOR THE DEGREE OF THE TURN AND CURRENT DRIVING CONDITIONS TO AVOID LOSS OF CONTROL.
- **SEATBELTS** SEATBELTS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN THE VEHICLE IS IN MOTION. THIS IS A REQUIREMENT FROM BOTH OUR WORKERS' COMPENSATION AND AUTO INSURANCE CARRIERS.
- NO EXCEPTIONS.
- BUCKLING THE BELT BEHIND YOU IS CONSIDERED A VIOLATION. IF YOU ARE CAUGHT,
  IT RESULTS IN AN IMMEDIATE WRITE-UP AND MAY LEAD TO SUSPENSION OR
  REVOCATION OF DRIVING PRIVILEGES.
- **DISTRACTED DRIVING** NO PHONE USE WHILE DRIVING.
- SERGEANTS AND PATROL OFFICERS NEEDING MAPS MUST USE ANDROID AUTO OR APPLE CARPLAY FOR VOICE-BASED NAVIGATION/TEXTING. BRING A CORD—THIS IS A SAFETY REQUIREMENT WITH ZERO TOLERANCE FROM THE INSURANCE CARRIER.
- **EATING WHILE DRIVING** DO NOT EAT WHILE THE VEHICLE IS IN MOTION. IF YOU NEED TO EAT, PULL OVER AND STOP, AND NOTIFY DISPATCH IF TAKING A BRIEF MEAL BREAK.
- LANE DEPARTURE MAINTAIN PROPER LANE DISCIPLINE AT ALL TIMES.
- **SPEED** OBEY POSTED SPEED LIMITS WITHIN 3–4 MPH. REDUCE SPEED DURING ADVERSE WEATHER (RAIN, SNOW, WIND).
- EMERGENCY CALL ASSISTS ARE THE ONLY EXCEPTION.
- FASTER SPEEDS REDUCE REACTION TIME, BURN MORE FUEL, AND INCREASE THE RISK OF INJURY IN A CRASH.
- DROWSINESS FALLING ASLEEP OR NODDING OFF WHILE DRIVING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- IF YOU ARE TOO TIRED, PULL OVER SAFELY AND NOTIFY DISPATCH THAT YOU NEED A SHORT BREAK OR TIME TO GET CAFFEINE. (CHEWING GUM MAY HELP.)
- CAMERA TAMPERING ZERO TOLERANCE.
- TWO VIOLATIONS RESULT IN TERMINATION.
- CHARGING/CONNECTION CORDS BRING YOUR OWN CABLE TO CONNECT YOUR PHONE TO THE VEHICLE'S INFOTAINMENT SYSTEM. THIS ENSURES SAFER MAP USAGE WITHOUT LOOKING DOWN AT YOUR PHONE.

## **ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS**

- DURING WIND, RAIN, SLEET, HAIL, OR OTHER HARSH WEATHER, THESE SAFETY PROCEDURES MUST BE FOLLOWED EVEN MORE DILIGENTLY—ESPECIALLY REGARDING:
- TURNING
- BRAKING
- FOLLOWING DISTANCE
- ADVERSE WEATHER SIGNIFICANTLY AFFECTS THESE ACTIONS. DRIVING DISTRACTED UNDER SUCH CONDITIONS GREATLY INCREASES THE CHANCES OF AN INCIDENT.

## **SEVERE WEATHER: TORNADO WARNING**

IF YOU ARE IN A COMPANY VEHICLE DURING A TORNADO WARNING:

- EXIT THE VEHICLE IMMEDIATELY AND LIE FLAT IN A DITCH.
- HIGH WINDS CAN LIFT BOTH YOU AND THE VEHICLE, CREATING A LIFE-THREATENING SITUATION.

### **SAMSARA ALERTS**

THE SAMSARA SYSTEM DETECTS SEVERAL OF THESE BEHAVIORS AND SENDS ALERTS. SOME ALERTS MAY BE INACCURATE AND WILL BE DISMISSED IF INCORRECT. ACCURATE ALERTS WILL RESULT IN:

- COACHING
- POSSIBLE WRITE-UPS DEPENDING ON FREQUENCY AND SEVERITY
